



BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.


The arrows in the figures denote fabric direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

## **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**


- 1. Place (1) C 2" square on the top of (1) I 2" x 15-1/2" strip, right sides together and aligning the tops of the fabrics. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.
- 2. Place another C 2" square on the bottom of the I 2" x 15-1/2" strip, right sides together and aligning the bottom of the fabrics. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip.
- **3.** Repeat **Steps 1-2** to make (12) **Unit 1** strips total.




4. Sew (1) B 2" x 13-1/2 strip to each side of (1) A 11" x 13-1/2" rectangle. Sew (1) B 2" x 14" strip to the top and to the bottom of the A rectangle to make (1) Unit 2 rectangle. Trim the unit to measure 12-1/2" x 15-1/2". Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 rectangles total.



5. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 rectangle to make (1) 15-1/2" Block One square. Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.





**6.** Place (1) **G** 3-1/2" square on the top left corner of (1) **F** 6-1/2" square, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.







- 7. Follow the diagram below for the seam direction to add a E 3-1/2" square to the lower right corner and (1) I 3-1/2" square to the lower left and upper right corners of the F 6-1/2" square to make (1) **Unit 3** square.
- **8.** Repeat **Steps 6-7** to make (6) **Unit 3** squares total.







**9.** Repeat **Steps 6-7** and refer to the diagrams below for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (6) of each unit square for **Unit 4** through **Unit 6**.










- **10.** Place (1) **I Template 1** triangle on top of (1) **C Template 2** triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides. Sew the (2) triangles together along the left side. Press the smaller triangle open.
- 11. Place (1) I Template 3 triangle on top of the C Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides. Sew the (2) triangles together along the right side. Press the smaller triangle open to make (1) Unit 7 square. Trim the unit to measure 3 ½" square.
- **12.** Repeat **Steps 10-11** to make (24) **Unit 7** squares total.









**13.** Repeat **Steps 10-11** and refer to the diagram below for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (24) **Unit 8** squares.



**14.** Sew (1) **Unit 7** square to the top of the (1) **Unit 8** square, along the **C** borders, to make (1) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" **Unit 9** strip. Repeat to make (24) **Unit 9** strips total.




- **15.** Sew together (1) **Unit 3** square, (1) **Unit 9** strip and (1) **Unit 4** square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row.
- **16.** Sew (1) **Unit 9** strip to each side of (1) **D** 3-1/2" square to make the middle row.
- 17. Sew together (1) Unit 5 square, (1) Unit 9 strip and (1) Unit 6 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row.
- **18.** Sew together the (3) rows from **Steps 15-17** lengthwise to make (1) 15-1/2" **Block Two** square.
- **19.** Repeat **Steps 15-18** to make (6) **Block Two** squares total.




## **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

- **20.** Sew (1) **Block One** square to each side of (1) **Block Two** square to make **Row One**. Repeat to make **Row Three**.
- **21.** Sew (1) **Block Two** square to each side of (1) **Block One** square to make **Row Two**. Repeat to make **Row Four.**
- **22.** Sew together the (4) **Rows** from **Steps 20-21**, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 45-1/2" x 60-1/2" **Center Block**.




- BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE E, H, I AND J BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.
- **23.** Sew (1) E 2" x (60-1/2") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) E 2" x (48-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.
- **24.** Center (1) H 4-1/4" x 75" strip on (1) side of the **Center Block** and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
- **25.** Repeat to sew (1) **H** 4-1/4" x 60" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the **Center Block** on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides.
- **26.** Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in the diagram below), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.



- 27. Sew (1) I 1-1/2" x (71") strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) I 1-1/2" x (58") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- **26.** Sew (1) **J** 5-1/2" x (73") strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) **J** 5-1/2" x (68") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

**FINISHING** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 67-1/2" x 82-1/2"
